We regret to inform that we have found it necessary to *postpone the 2nd International Conference on Negative CO₂ Emissions by one year, to May 18-21, 2021*, due to the outbreak of Corona virus. This means:

1. **If you have registered and paid**, you may choose to (i) keep your registration and payment with us, (ii) request a refund. Our registration fee may need to increase next year due to increased costs of venues and catering. If you keep your payment with us we will not charge any extra amount next year. If you are unable to make the rearranged date, you may ask for full refund minus an administrative fee of 250 SEK. 2. **If you are an author**, you can choose to withdraw your paper from the conference, *please see detailed information for authors below*. Please inform us of your decision.
3. **If you have already purchased air tickets**, we sincerely apologize for the inconvenience and if you need any official letter to negotiate with the airlines we will definitely assist you. Please let us know if so.

We will open a new call for abstracts to attract additional papers. This will also involve a new deadline for submission of papers, March 15, 2021.

However, *all abstracts that have been evaluated and accepted for oral presentations remain accepted*, under the condition that you (1) have already submitted a paper, (2) will submit a paper before this year's manuscript deadline, now extended to March 31, 2020, or (3) will submit your paper later, i.e. before next year's deadline, March 15 2021.

Thus, we ask you to inform us by e-mail:

- A. If you choose to withdraw your paper,
- B. If you plan to submit a paper. (No action needed if you submit before March 31, 2020)

If you choose to submit your paper before this year's deadline (March 31, 2020) you will have the following benefits:

- You may refer to your paper as finally accepted for the *2nd Int. Conf. on Negative CO₂ Emissions*.
- The procedure for publishing your paper in the Topical Collection "2nd International Conf. on Negative CO₂ Emissions" in Mitigation and Adaptation Strategies for Global Change (MITI) will be initiated, provided you select this option when submitting. This means that if your paper passes the preselection, you will be invited to submit your paper to be reviewed for this Collection, likely before the summer.
- You will still have the possibility to submit an updated version before next year's deadline.

Please note: The conference papers will be distributed on a USB memory stick to the conference participants, and not in any printed proceedings or on the internet. Consequently, these papers should not be a hindrance for publication in scientific journals.
